## **Religious Education & Health**

Our topic for this term is Te Atua - God. We will be looking at the concept of revelation and how God reveals God to us in our everyday lives. The beauty of creation will be explored and an appreciation of the love and complexity of what God has created. We will develop an understanding that we may not always feel the presence of God, but that God is always with us and we can continue to search for this throughout our lives. We will also look at human sexuality through the Catholic lens - more information will follow on this subject.

# **Mathematics**

This term students will be learning about statistics and completing statistical investigations in class. Students will learn what makes a good research question and how to effectively gather data. We will cover different types of graphs and learn how to interpret and analyse the data that they show. Students will draw conclusions and critically reflect on their own investigations.

### Literacy

We will be completing in-depth novel studies this term. Students will explore the setting, characters, plot and themes in the novels that they read. Our writing focus this term will be

editing and proof reading. Students will work on critically reviewing their own written work to improve the overall quality and effectiveness of their writing.

# **Health & Physical Education**

This term we have school athletics. For some students this will lead onto zone, interzone and regional events. We are also attending three multi-sport days at Akau Tangi Sports Arena in Wellington in the first half of the term. This will be a great opportunity for enjoyment and development as we try several new and exciting sports.

#### Arts

We look forward to our area show at the end of the term. Students will participate in acting, dancing and singing opportunities as we prepare for the show and then get the chance to perform for the school and their families.
